The event aimed to provide firsthand knowledge about the Indian Air Force's technical operations and equipment's, also enhancing their understanding of communication and defence strategies.

Upon entering the Air Force Station, the cadets received a warm welcome from the Air Force officials. A photo session was held at the entrance featuring the officials of the Air Force. Following that, the cadets were divided into two groups and guided through the technical areas of the station. They were introduced to the latest equipment being used by the Indian Air Force in wartime communication scenarios and various other operations. They were also briefed on the working of communication towers and long-range radars. They were also given brief about the arms that are being used currently at that station. After an informative tour, the cadets were taken to the Air Force Station Mess for lunch, followed by a visit to the renowned Temple before concluding their journey. At last, ANO Capt. Anil Rana Sir expressed a sense of gratitude to them for providing this opportunity to the cadets.

## NCC Enrollment

On 09 September 2024, enrollment for batch 2024 was organized at the campus of Chitkara University, Himachal Pradesh. Chitkara University initiated its NCC enrollment program with aim to encourage the students to be a responsible citizen of our nation. Enrollment was open for both male and female students of First Year. The day began with NCC Cadets briefing the candidates about the enrollment process.

The rate of participation has been encouraging, with a total of 62 students from 1<sup>st</sup> year who actively participated in it. Two staff personnel from NCC Unit 1 HP BN NCC Solan, Naib Subedar Sanjeev Kumar and Havaldar Ajay Kumar, witnessed the whole process. The process included a variety of events starting with the height measurements, and they were allotted a token number for further process. The first stage involved a running test of 600 M for boys and 400 M for girls, which evaluated the endurance, stamina and physical fitness of the participants. Further, the process involved a long jump for both categories, where students participated actively. Following this, boys performed a few sets of crunches. After the physical evaluations, each candidate appeared for the Written test, which assessed their general knowledge, understanding of current affairs, and awareness about NCC. The performance of students in both the physical and written tests was taken into consideration for the final result. A total of 19 SD's and 08 SW's were selected, along with the cadets in the reserve category. Further, the candidates were shortlisted for a small interview round, discussing their reasons for joining NCC. PI Staff also briefed the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> year cadets, focusing on their B & C certificate exam, weapon handling, and drill. The session was highly informative.

Chitkara University hosted the PI Staff cheerfully and facilitated them for conducting the whole process. The event was concluded by providing refreshments to all the cadets, boosting their morale. Selected cadets are expected to undergo their training in a few days.

## ***World First Aid Day***

On 14 September, 2024 a First Aid Workshop was organised by NCC Cadets on the occasion of World First Aid Day along with the Nursing Department of Chitkara University, Baddi that aims to enhance the cadets' understanding in administering First Aid and focused on basic lifesaving skills like CPR and other emergency tactics. The workshop was attended by 32 cadets and various First Aid techniques were demonstrated to them by Trained Nursing Faculty.

The workshop was started with a seminar, delivered by experienced nursing faculty, emphasizing the importance of First Aid and its need. The speaker highlighted the significance of remaining calm and composed in emergency situations with appropriate actions to tackle it. Further, Cadets were divided among 6 groups and each group was allotted a Station where practical demonstrations were given by Nursing Students. Each station was demonstrating a different situation like CPR, Animal bites, Types of Wounds, Usage of bandages, transportation of injured person and basic First Aid components and their usage. Cadets did hands-on practice of several techniques providing them knowledge and experience. The interactive nature of the workshop ensured that each participant had the opportunity to engage and practise the first aid techniques. It helped them build confidence and prepare them to respond effectively in real-life emergencies.

Event was concluded by facilitating the Nursing faculty and a group photo with them. The workshop helped the cadets to know more about First Aid, thereby contributing to a safer and more prepared society. It also encouraged everyone to take up the responsibility of learning and spreading these essential skills.

## ***NCC Day Celebration***

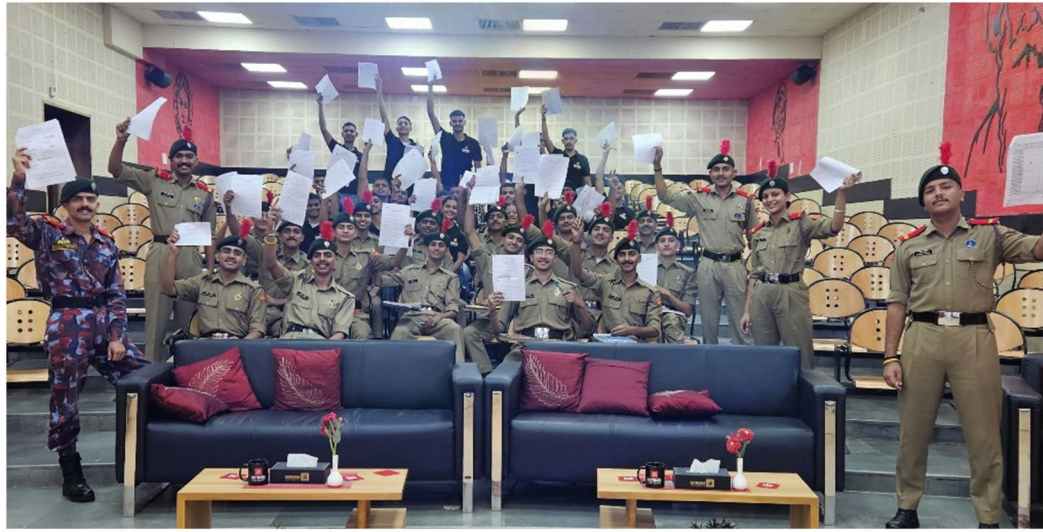

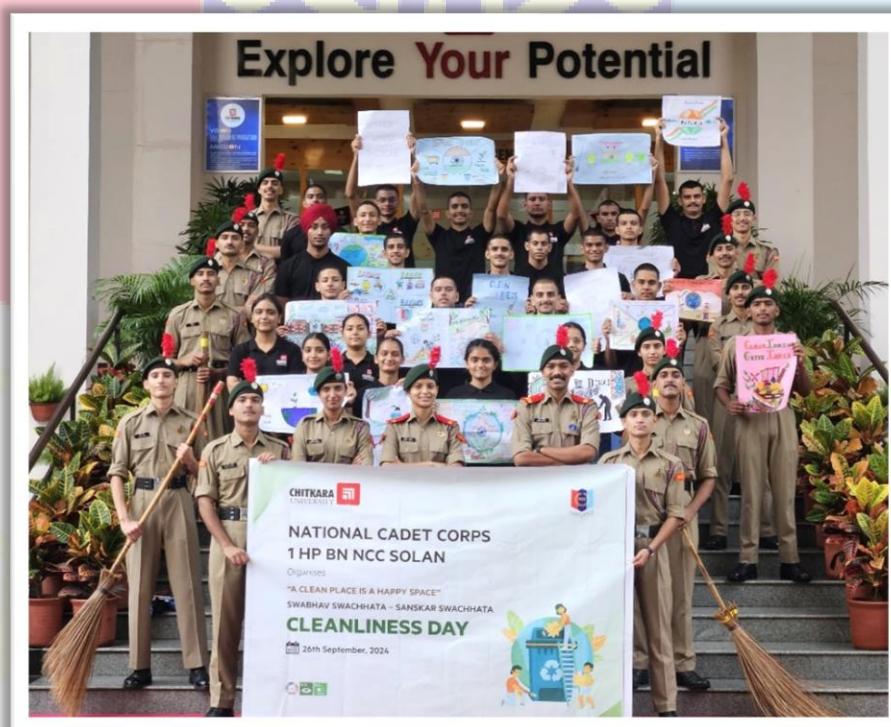
