





Later he emphasized on the importance of soft skills like communication, organization, analytical abilities, creativity, project management, perseverance, problem solving, resourcefulness, curiosity and interest in helping others which will lead to a great future ahead in the IT sector.

He talked on the topic "The Career Masterclass" in which he gave important tips on how to prepare for a job interview. The following are some important interview points and questions he discussed with the students.

- 1. Review the job description
- 2. Learn more about the company
- 3. Prepare a list of expected interview questions Tell me about yourself.
- Why are you looking for a job change? Why do you want this job?
- · What are your strengths and weaknesses? What motivates you?
- Where do you see yourself in five years?
- 4. Be polite and mindful of your body language.
- 4. Ask thoughtful questions to the interviewer

He concluded the webinar by encouraging the students with the motto "Don't give up on your dreams!"







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
