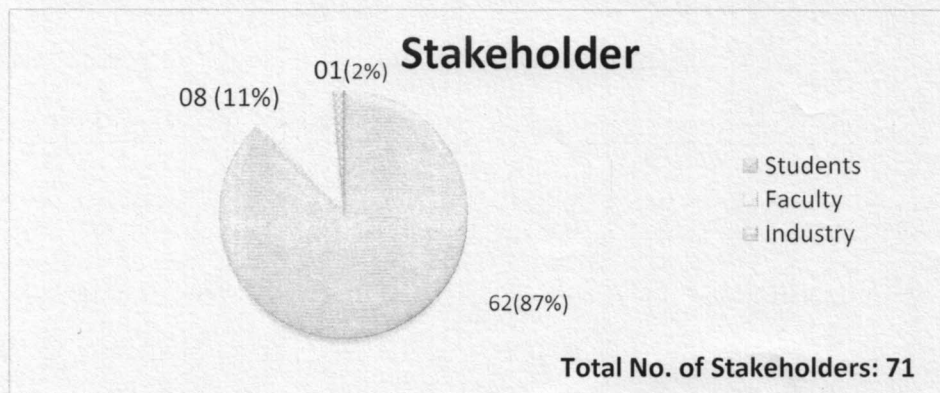

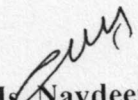
STAKEHOLDER FEEDBACK REPORT 2020-2021

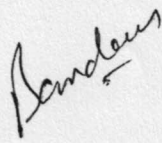

7.	Requested to include more reference books related to	Students Feedback	Library committees along with subject incharges were guided to prepare a list of updated books of

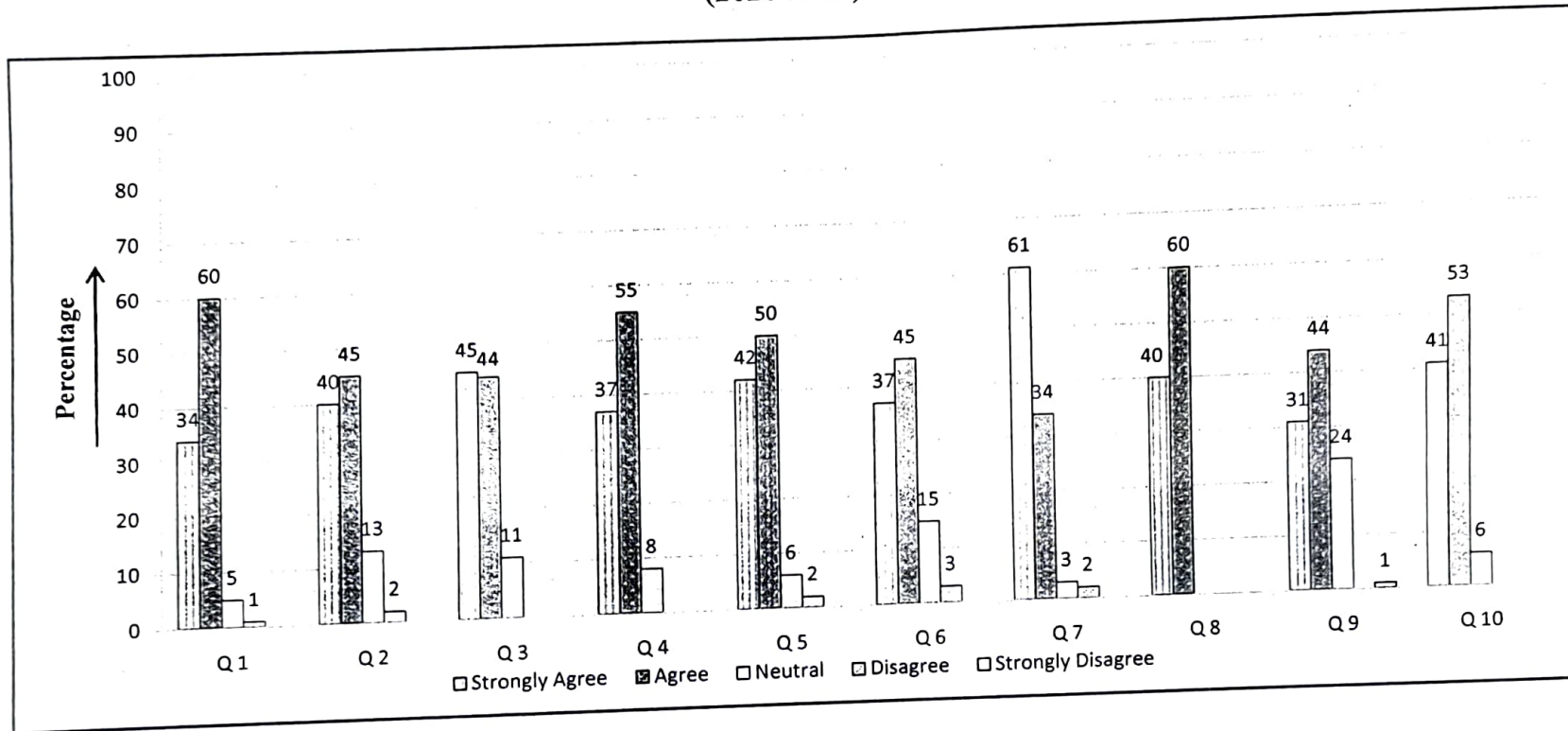

8.	Organize sessions on qualifying competitive examination.	Students Feedback	Faculty members were advised to plan sessions on the preparation of competitive examinations and to include multiple-choice questions at the end of the lecture.
9.	More opportunities to participate in extracurricular activities.	Students Feedback	Student Nurses Association (SNA) committee was suggested to plan extracurricular activities for the students so that they can participate in these activities and be more confident as these activities will also be helpful in personality development.
10.	Asked to provide E-content for a better learning experience.	Students Feedback	Faculty members were asked to provide E-books and authentic website links to the students.
11.	Demanded to provide previous years' question papers.	Students Feedback	Subject in-charges were guided to prepare question bank.
12.	Requested to use different methods of teaching-learning and evaluation. 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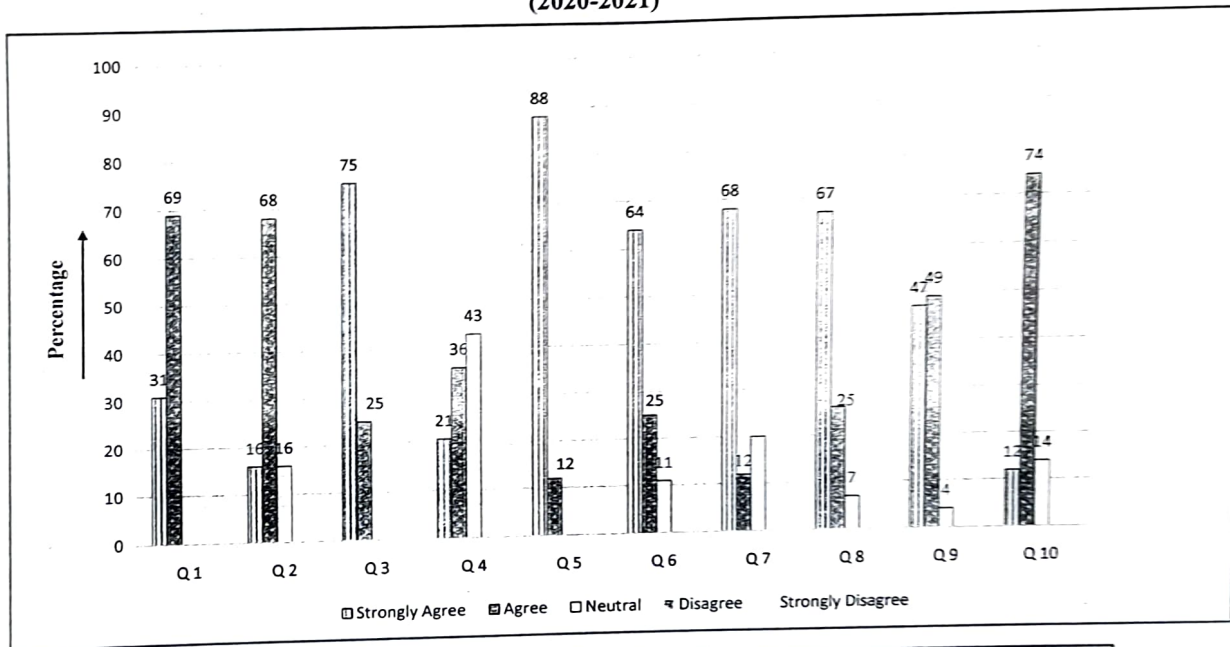
STUDENT FEEDBACK ANALYSIS (2020-2021)

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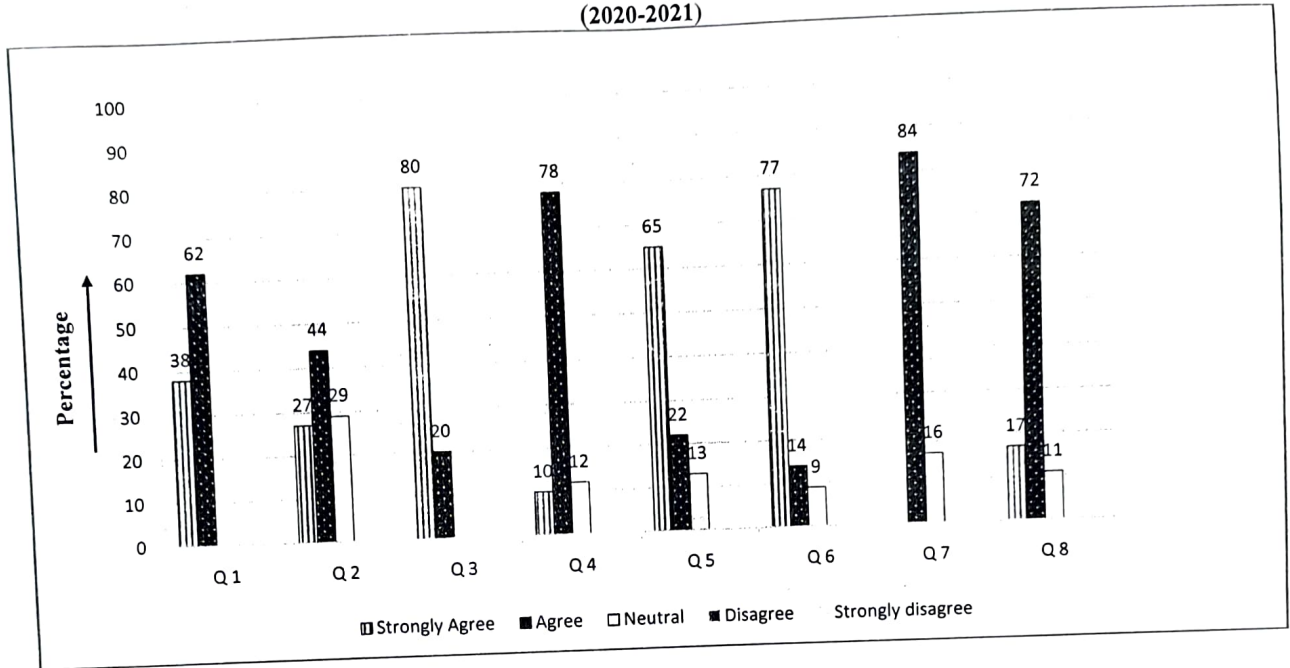
FACULTY FEEDBACK ANALYSIS (2020-2021)

Q5: The students are able to work in team and lead the team effectively to manage the project.

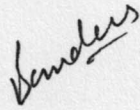
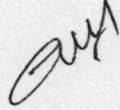
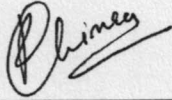
Q6: The students adopt the changes and willing to learn new technologies.
