



## NEONATAL RESUSCITATION- MASTERING TECHNIQUES FOR THE FIRST MINUTE OF LIFE

**Date of Event: 26 October 2024** 

Description: The session focused on preparing students to manage complex paediatric cases, emphasizing the importance of specialized education and simulation-based learning in developing critical clinical skills. Dr. Surjeet Kumar, an expert in Paediatrics and Neonatology from Dr. Y.S. Parmar Government Medical College and Hospital, led the session & emphasized on the physiological changes that occur during the transition from fetal to neonatal life, focusing on the importance of breathing initiation, circulatory changes, and thermoregulation. He expounded on the role of the APGAR score in assessing newborns at 1 and 5 minutes post-delivery, specifying how the score helps determine whether resuscitation is necessary or not. Dr. Kumar shared his vast experience and insights into neonatal resuscitation, with particular emphasis on the newborn's transition from intrauterine to extrauterine life and the essential steps to manage any immediate complications during this period. He encouraged the participants to continue developing their skills and understanding, as neonatal emergencies are often unpredictable and require rapid, decisive action. The session concluded with an interactive Q&A, where Dr. Kumar addressed specific queries from the nursing students regarding the practical aspects of neonatal resuscitation and the latest updates in neonatal care.
